As usual, this has been a busy volunteer season. The early part of the season including a lot of new planting and landscaping followed by removing trees that have been raising and breaking streets, sidewalks and driveways – most of which then needed subsequent repair. We been upgrading the lights in the chapel with new LCD bulbs that will save us money and give us brighter lighting options.

Refurbishing of apartments is always on the list of to-do projects. This year was no exception. Almost all our housing is either occupied or is designated for specific people to occupy this year or next year. This means that next winter's projects will

likely include a lot of renovation or refurbishing work.

After a lengthy wait for all the appropriate permits, we were finally able to begin work on the back gate. We, ourselves, did as much of the work as we could including installing a culvert in an existing ditch, pouring a section of road, busting through walls, constructing the gates and tracks, and laying conduit. We are waiting on heavy-duty motors to power the gates and additional electrical work to be done. It is our hope that the project will be finished and approved by the city before the end of April.
