Dear Friends,

It has long been our vision to build a larger maintenance facility where we can store and service both the large and small machinery used to care for the 40 acres of missionary retirement housing here at The Homes of Ethnos360.



Most of the work on our property is done by our dedicated staff—not outsourced—which means we rely heavily on a wide range of equipment. For many years, we've made do with limited and inadequate maintenance space. After much prayer and consideration, we'd like to share our vision with you:

Maintenance Building Project

- **Size:** 60x100 steel building (with potential for future expansion)
- Estimated Cost:
 - \$100,000 for steel frame and shell
 - \$100,000 for concrete flooring
 - \$50,000 for equipment setup
- Timeline: We hope to begin as soon as funding is available



In addition, we've been praying about another pressing need: replacing our aging mailboxes. Initially, we hoped to restore the existing steel boxes through sandblasting, welding, and painting. However, we've come to realize they are beyond repair. Many of our more than 35-year-old mailboxes are held together with duct tape, and beneath it lies rusted, crumbling metal. Unfortunately, the postal service does not provide replacements.

Mailbox Replacement Project

- **Need:** Seven cluster mailboxes
- **Cost:** \$2,000 per cluster mailbox
